We increased our giving by \$10,000, and have plans to increase it even more next year. Best of all, hundreds of members voted again this year in an extraordinary example of collective giving.

In response to some really insightful member feedback last year, we changed our grants voting process so that all members got to actually rank each finalist, instead of just choosing two out of three.

As part of that change, all three of our finalists received awards: one of \$10,000, one of \$20,000 and one of \$30,000. This revised process feels great to us because it preserves the ability of members to choose the grants that they find most compelling, but it also acknowledges what we all know: that each of our finalists does incredible and valuable work, and is more than deserving of our support.
